**1** Initial Reading  
(manual or automatic)

**Remember:**  
**Proper measurement technique**



↓ High Reading:  $\geq 130/80$  (ACC/AHA, 2017) ↓

**2** AOBP Reading  
(at least 3 readings averaged)

**Remember:**  
**Patient entirely alone**  
**MA should be engaged in productive clinical activities**



↓ High Reading:  $\geq 130/80$  (ACC/AHA, 2017) ↓

**3** Patient Home BP Monitoring

**Remember:**  
**Patient needs training**  
**Plan to capture readings in EMR**
