One of the best ways to close the vaccine communication loop among providers is to use your state's immunization information system (IIS) to assess patient vaccination status and to update documentation on vaccines administered.

Idaho



Idaho's Immunization Reminder Information System (IRIS) is a computerized Internet database application that was developed to record and track immunization dates of Idaho's children and adults, providing assistance for keeping everyone on track for their recommended immunizations.

Nevada



Nevada state law mandates that all immunizers report to the registry for patients of all ages. WebIZ collects immunizations data for pediatric and adult vaccines from both public and private health care providers to create complete records for individuals in Nevada, and can be accessed by any provider to help assess vaccine status for their patients. Nevada WebIZ also has a patient portal where individuals or their guardians can access their own vaccination records.

The New Mexico Statewide Immunization Information System (NMSIIS) is a secure and centralized database that can store an individual's immunization history. New Mexico's state statute (24-5-8) requires that all vaccinations be recorded in NMSIIS.

Oregon



The Oregon Health Authority ALERT IIS collects immunization data from both public and private health care providers to create complete records for individuals in Oregon. Data submission to Oregon's IIS is required for pharmacies and public clinics, including Federally Qualified Health Centers. All clinics participating in the federally funded Vaccines for Children program are also required to submit data.

The Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) is a secure, confidential immunization information system that helps health care providers, schools, childcare centers and Utah residents maintain consolidated immunization histories. There is no law mandating health care providers send immunization information to USIIS. Reporting is voluntary only.
