



Nevada AHEC Scholars Participation Agreement

The Nevada AHEC Scholars program is for health profession students wishing to enhance their education by gaining additional leadership knowledge and experience in rural and/or underserved urban settings.

AHEC Scholars are required to complete 40 hours in clinical and 40 hours in didactic learning opportunities each year with a minimum of 160 hours being met at the end of the two-year commitment.

AHEC Scholars are expected to adhere to the following regarding:

Commitment

- Four academic semester commitment
- Participate in monthly approved Scholar meetings and learning activities
- Engage, reflect, and provide feedback through the NV AHEC Learning Portal
- Read all email communications
- Assist with identifying new opportunities for engagement
- Upon completion of the program, each Scholar agrees to write a letter of intent indicating future professional endeavors and to provide annual professional status updates through survey participation.

Conduct

- Maintain professionalism in clinical and didactic activities
- Agrees to respond to emails and other correspondence from AHEC staff in a timely manner, usually within 48 business hours
- Possess the ability to effectively interact with persons from various social, cultural, economic, and educational backgrounds
- Work directly with AHEC Staff, who will provide mentorship and guidance on all clinical and didactic learning activities

Should commitment to the Nevada AHEC Scholars program become unrealistic, for either personal or professional reasons, please contact AHEC Staff as soon as possible.
